Re: Burning Permits

Dear Citizens,

Depending upon the size of you burn pile, it may no longer be necessary to call the Forestry Office to acquire a Burn Permit to burn small yard waste (including leaves and limbs.) You can now call 1-877-ok2-burn (1-877-652-2876) to acquire a burn permit for small yard waste provided that the size of trash pile to be burned does not exceed a 6-foot square area. It is not permissible or legal to burn household trash, rubber or lumber with any burn permit.

If your burn pile is larger than 6-foot square, you must continue to contact the Forestry Office at 229-333-5267 to acquire a Burn Permit. A permit from the Forestry Office is also required for burning as would be associated with clearing land or burning off acreage.

Please remember that you are both responsible and liable for your fire and the resulting smoke. In accordance with the City of Lake Park Burn Ordinance, all fires must be put completely out before dark. No burning is allowed during nighttime hours or on Sunday's.
