Call Meeting Minutes

Monday September 19, 2016 7:30 PM

Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:31 PM. He began by leading the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silence for the victims of the recent bombings in New York and New Jersey.

Those present were as follows; Mayor Eric Schindler, Mayor Pro Tem Debbie Sauls, Council Members Carter, Rutland, and Sandlin, Clerk, Fire Chief Brown, Maintenance Supervisor Patterson, Fire Department volunteers, and citizens.

Mayor called on Fire Chief David Brown to come before Council to report what information he had gathered on the transport of the 1998 International 6000 gallon tanker. Brown explained that a total estimated cost to transport the tanker would be around \$4500. That amount includes \$3,000 to trucking company, \$865 for air fare, \$140 (2 days) per diem, \$100 rental car, \$50 fuel, and \$175 hotel (2 nights).

Chief Brown introduced Levy Rentz and Steve Spradley, Georgia Forestry Commission and asked Council if they had any questions regarding the tanker or the agreement for the appropriation of the vehicle.

Member Rutland made a motion to appropriate funds up to \$6,000 payable from the SPLOST VII for the expenses incurred for obtaining and transporting the 1998 International 6000 gallon tanker, Member Carter second for discussion. When question called Members Rutland, Carter, and Sauls for, Member Sandlin oppose, motion passed.

Member Rutland made a motion to adjourn at 8:00, Member Sandlin second, all in favor, motion passed.
