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Emergency Call Meeting

Wednesday September 17, 2014 8:30 PM

Minutes

Mayor Schindler called the meeting to order at 8:32 PM. Those present were as follows; Mayor Schindler, Mayor Pro Tem Carter, Council Members Mulkey and Rutland. Also present were Police Chief Breletic and Clerk.

First item on the agenda was police equipment. Mayor called on Police Chief Breletic to approach Council to discuss the item of business. Chief reported that the 2008 Crowne Victoria (slick top) had electrical issues causing the vehicle to be unusable. He advised that he and Chief Brown had no luck in chasing the electrical issue. The vehicle had been taken to Langdale Ford and luckily was able to be repaired. Chief Breletic stated that all repairs would now be documented and diagraph and kept on record for each vehicle. Member Carter urged Council to keep in mind that a vehicle purchase will be on the horizon and they should budget accordingly for the next year. No action taken at this time.

Member Rutland made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss citizens by name and taxes owed, Member Mulkey second the motion, all in favor motion passed. Council entered into Executive Session at 8:45 PM.

Member Rutland made a motion leave Executive Session and return to the Emergency Call Meeting, Member Mulkey second, all in favor motion passed. Council reentered Emergency Call Meeting at 8:58 PM.

Mayor Pro Tem Carter made a motion to allow the Mayor to sign the Executive Session resolution and affidavit, Member Rutland second, all in favor, motion passed.

Member made a motion to mail certified letters to all citizens on the 2013 delinquent tax list stating that all past due property taxes should be paid in full by December 31, 2014 otherwise the City of Lake Park would begin the process of intent to levy. Member Mulkey second the motion, all in favor motion passed.

Member Rutland asked to question Police Chief Breletic. Mayor asked Chief Breletic to approach Council. Member Rutland asked the Chief to explain the issue that exists between the City of Lake Park Police Department and the Lowndes County Jail. After discussion the Mayor stated that he had contacted Attorney Plumb regarding the agreement between the city and the county. Mayor and Council asked Chief Breletic to keep them posted as to the evolvement of the issues.

Being no further business, meeting adjourned.


